AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 105 OF THE CITY OF NEW GERMANY ESTABLISHING A RURAL SERVICE DISTRICT BY AMENDING SECTION 6 PERTAINING TO BENEFIT RATIO AND TAX RATE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW GERMANY, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 105 of the City of New Germany pertaining to the Benefit Ratio and Tax Rate of the Rural Service District is amended to read as follows:

Section 6. BENEFIT RATIO AND TAX RATE.


It is the judgment of the City Council that the approximate ratio that exists between the benefits resulting from the tax supported municipal services to parcels of land of like market value, situated in the rural service district and in the urban service district, respectively, is 19.00%. However, in no event shall the tax rate for the rural service district be less than what the tax rate for such parcel would be if taxed by the township in which the parcel is located. Any taxes levied for the payment of bonds and judgments and interest thereon shall be in addition to such tax.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
