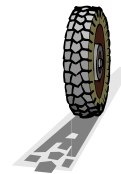
The Commercial Club will start to meet again. The first meeting of the fall is Monday September 26, 2016 at 7 PM. Everybody is welcome to join.

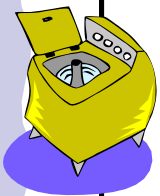
Please Note: the majority of the prices are to help even out the city fees when disposing of these items. They are the actual cost to the city.

If no one is available at any of these number please use the 911. You do not need to leave a note or phone message at the City office unless you want to file a formal complaint. *The sheriff can respond to an incident while it is happening instead of hearing about it later, when they can no longer do anything about it.* You can request your name be withheld. There are some issues that need to be dealt with while they are happening for better results.
