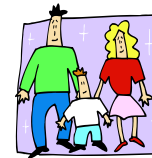

SEWER REMINDERS

- FLUSHABLE WET WIPES SHOULD NOT BE FLUSHED.
 - DO NOT flush rigid or gritty materials down drains such as cat litter, coffee grounds, chicken bones, egg shells, fish scales, etc. Limit the materials you put through a garbage disposal to edible food products only.
 - DO NOT pour grease or oil down drains. Grease such as cooking oils, tallow, bacon grease, etc. will harden in the lines, and on the float switches, causing the pumps not to work.
 - DO NOT flush non-biodegradable items down drains. Items such as cigarette butts, dental floss, Q-tips, disposable diapers, sanitary napkins, tampons or condoms can clog the pump and pipes.
 - DO NOT pour household chemicals down drains, such as paint, pesticides, herbicides, strong cleaning products, OR waste oil, gas, and thinners. It is illegal to dispose of these items in the sewer system.
 - DO NOT LET YOUR SUMP PUMP RUN INTO THE SANITARY SEWER
- These items all cause problems that is very costly to taxpayers to repair.

Solar in New Germany

Council has denied the proposed solar project in New Germany for the following findings:

1. It is too close to downtown and is surrounded by existing homes and a park. Solar should be in a more rural area.
2. It is a planned residential area with access to public utilities. The city does not want to lose the residential land inventory.
3. The loss of residential land reduces growth opportunities, taxable property and more residents to support local businesses.
4. If it is located in the city, it should be in the Agricultural District with appropriate setbacks from existing homes.
5. There are a lot of wetlands on the property and existing drainage issues.
