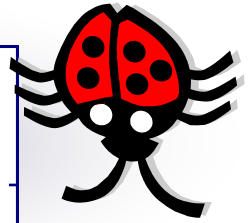

PLEASE READ THE PARKING ORDINANCE—SEVERAL TRALERS IN VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 85-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85 REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE CITY LIMITS OF NEW GERMANY

The City Council of the City of New Germany, Carver County, Minnesota does hereby Ordain that Ordinance No. 85 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 1.

Overtime Parking and Parking of Commercial Vehicles. No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle, non motor vehicle or trailer whether attended or unattended, upon any public street, public alleyway or public lot for a period of time longer than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours. No trucks licensed gross vehicle weight above 15,000 lbs and requiring DOT certification or truck trailer shall be parked on any public street or public alleyway between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle or trailer unless it is in the process of being loaded or unloaded so as to block any public street or public alleyway at any time.

Section 2.

Designation of No Parking Zones and Limited Parking Zones. The City Council of the City of New Germany may also from time to time, designate certain streets and alleys or portions thereof, as “No Parking” Zones or as “Limited Parking” Zones for a period of time. These Zones would be properly marked to reflect their parking character.

SEWER REMINDERS

- **FLUSHABLE WET WIPES SHOULD NOT BE FLUSHED.**
 - **DO NOT** flush rigid or gritty materials down drains such as cat litter, coffee grounds, chicken bones, egg shells, fish scales, etc. Limit the materials you put through a garbage disposal to edible food products only.
 - **DO NOT** pour grease or oil down drains. Grease such as cooking oils, tallow, bacon grease, etc. will harden in the lines, and on the float switches, causing the pumps not to work.
 - **DO NOT** flush non-biodegradable items down drains. Items such as cigarette butts, dental floss, Q-tips, disposable diapers, sanitary napkins, tampons or condoms can clog the pump and pipes.
 - **DO NOT** pour household chemicals down drains, such as paint, pesticides, herbicides, strong cleaning products, **OR** waste oil, gas, and thinners. It is illegal to dispose of these items in the sewer system.
 - **DO NOT LET YOUR SUMP PUMP RUN INTO THE SANITARY SEWER**
- These items all cause problems that is very costly to taxpayers to repair.
