They also accept automotive batteries, clothing, cans, glass bottles, scrap metal, used motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, and more.

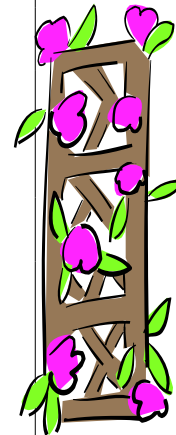

Do not flush non biodegradable items down the drain, such as cigarette butts, dental floss, disposable diapers, bandages, cotton balls and swabs, female products, medications and like items. Do not put household chemicals down the drains, such as paint and strong cleaning products. Basically the only thing you should be flushing down your toilets is human waste and toilet paper.

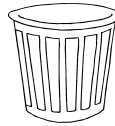

### Sheriff number to call in complaints - all calls use 911

If you need to notify somebody of a barking dog (day or night), or late night noises, or fireworks, etc., or anything that is not an emergency, you still use the 911 number. You do not need to leave a note or phone message at the city office *unless you want to file a formal complaint*. The Sheriff can respond to an incident while it is happening instead of hearing about it later, when they can no longer do anything about it. You can request your name be withheld. There are some issues that need to be dealt with while they are happening for better results.
