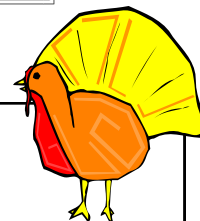

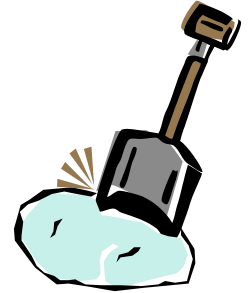
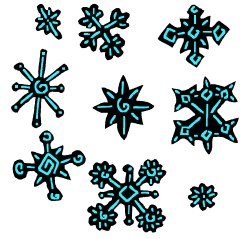
**WINTER & SNOWFALL PARKING
RULES**

Parking—No Parking on City Streets between 2am & 7am beginning Nov. 1 thru March 31

Snowfall Parking Rules—No Parking on city streets following a snowfall of 1” or more.

Penalty—If your car is parked illegally during snow plowing, the Sheriffs Dept. will be called and you will receive a ticket.

Sidewalks—It is your responsibility to keep your sidewalk free from snow & ice.

PET SAFETY AT CHRISTMAS

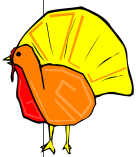
Christmas trees and holiday decorations are pretty, but be careful about what you put out this season. Avoid tinsel and don’t let your pet drink the live tree water.
