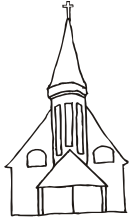

**Garbage and Recycling Transition**

**Garbage Services will be changing effective October 1, 2020 from Republic Services to Waste Management.**

**Anyone needing a different GARBAGE size should call the CITY at 952-353-2488 to get that swap scheduled.**

**All RECYCLING carts will be 96 gallons, if you would like smaller size, they can be swapped out at a later date. Recycling cart is a flat rate no matter the size; all the same price.**

**THURSDAYS will continue to be the pickup day. In the future for picking up bulk items you will call Waste Management directly and prepay for your items, all other changes will go through the CITY.**

**Recycling will be every other week. Garbage is every Thursday, curbside by 7 AM. Waste Management recycling will start on October 1, 2020.**

**As a reminder, Republic Services will be picking up their carts Friday, September 24, 2020, please have carts to the curb by 7 AM. Waste Management will be delivering new carts on September 21.**

**Sheriff number to call in complaints - all calls use 911**  
If you need to notify somebody of a barking dog (day or night), or late night noises, speeding vehicles or fireworks, etc., or anything that is not an emergency, you still use the 911 number. You do not need to leave a note or phone message at the city office *unless you want to file a formal complaint*. The Sheriff can respond to an incident while it is happening instead of hearing about it later, when they can no longer do anything about it. You can request your name be withheld.

**NOTICE ATV, UTV, DIRT BIKES AND VEHICLES**  
The City of New Germany has had complaints on reckless driving of ATV, dirt bikes and UTV's on Park Street East. Also, complaint on the amount of ATV, dirt bikes and UTV's coming from Black Forest area that appear to be commuting to liquor establishments, speeding, wheelies etc., There are several children on Park street that ride bicycles and commute to the playground. All vehicles need to obey the traffic signs, not just UTV, dirt bikes and ATV. Council reviewed ordinances pertaining to ATV, dirt bikes and UTV; as of this time Council will not be adopting an ordinance. First step is to inform residents of the laws and hope that residents will obey the laws. Please review the dirt bike, ATV, and UTV guidelines and apply. Let's work together and obey the laws so we can all enjoy dirt bikes, ATV, and UTV riding, just slow down and keep your wheels grounded and most important WATCH FOR CHILDREN!! Vehicles make sure you are not speeding, stopping at stop signs, not rolling through!
