

WATER/SEWER BILL INFORMATION

Water and sewer rates will no longer include the first 1,000 gallons in the base rate. Instead, the new monthly base rate for Water in 2021 is \$28.65, a decrease of \$15.15 per month, and all water usage will be billed at \$0.197 per 10 gallons of water. This is an increase of \$0.0218 per 10 gallons from last year. The monthly meter fee is \$1.84. The monthly base rate for Sewer is dropping to \$25.99, down from \$41.70, and the sewer usage rate for all usage is \$0.201 per 10 gallons, which is an increase of \$0.0224 from last year. This includes a 9% increase in the rates- which will be reflected in the January billing. The City Council worked closely with the City's financial advisors, Ehlers to develop the new structures. They reviewed many different options, with the main goal of minimizing rate increases while ensuring both funds can pay for operating costs and existing debt service. In a small city there is less people to spread the debt over which makes higher water and sewer rates. Looking ahead, the Council is also working on the current capacity limits of the sewer ponds, which limits new construction in the City. The Council is working closely with SEH (city engineering firm) to complete a study to look at options to resolve this problem. Once the study is completed, Council will review the results and move forward with a plan. Regardless of the outcome, the project is expected to take several years to complete. Once the sewer pond issue has been resolved, we can continue with growth in the city. Future updates will be posted in the newsletter.

Options for paying your Utility Bill: Security Bank New Germany, Regular Mail, Drop box on the front of City Hall, or online at www.ub-pay.com, you will need the municipal code on your Utility bill. When sending your payment in please make sure and tear off the bottom portion of the post card, the upper portion is your copy. You may need to write your manual reading on the stub of the post card if you still have a manual read meter when you drop off your payment.

Water Bills are due the 15th of each month. If you are still one of the 7 manual reads, you are required to send in your water reading. If you do not send in a water meter reading you will be **charged a penalty fee of \$10.00. This is only if your meter is a manual read meter.** Any bill that is delinquent more than 60 days can legally be shut off. Each certified letter that is mailed is costly. If you can't pay your bill in full—make a partial payment. If you can't pay anything at least send in or CALL in a meter reading—You will at least save yourself the \$10 penalty. Leave a message after hours or write it on a piece of paper with your address and drop in the drop box. There is a shut-off fee of \$25 and a reconnect fee of \$25. There are 7 meters left to replace and every-one will be on auto reads. Auto reads do not need to write any meter readings. Call if you are unsure if you are an auto read.

Options for paying your Utility Bill: Security Bank New Germany, Regular Mail, Drop box on the front of City Hall, or online at www.ub-pay.com, you will need the municipal code on your Utility bill. When sending your payment in please make sure and tear off the bottom portion of the post card, the upper portion is your copy. You may write your manual reading on the stub of the post card and drop off with payment.



SNOW REMINDERS

If it snows on the day of garbage or recycle collection, please keep your **containers off of the road** so the city streets can be plowed. If you put them out on Wednesday night they must be in your driveway and not on the road. Also please do not push your driveway or sidewalk snow into the street.

Remember: The recycle center and brush site by Mayer is only open Saturday mornings until April. Then it is open Wednesdays 5-8pm in addition to Saturday mornings.

NO PARKING on city streets following a snowfall of 1" or more. NO parking on city streets between 2am and 7am Nov. 1 thru March 31. The Sheriff Dept. will be called and you will be ticketed.

The city contracts for sanitation service. If you have a garbage request (i.e. need a new can) please call the city office.

Building Permits need to be obtained before the work begins. Call the City to determine if a permit is needed for the job.
