
# New Germany Monthly News



## WATER/SEWER BILL INFORMATION

Water and sewer rates will slightly increase for 2023, this will take place on the January billing cycle. Monthly base rate for Water will be \$32.80, all water usage will be billed at \$0.2255 per 10 gallons of water. The monthly meter fee is \$1.84. The monthly base rate for Sewer is \$29.20, sewer usage rate for all usage is \$0.2258 per 10 gallons. Garbage rates will increase in October 2023 to the following rates; 35 gallon SR rate \$9.30, 35 gallon \$10.62, 64 gallon \$13.44, 96 gallon \$15.63, recycling \$5.45.

Options for paying your Utility Bill: Security Bank New Germany, Regular Mail, Drop box on the front of City Hall, or online at <a href="https://www.ub-pay.com">www.ub-pay.com</a>, you will need the municipal code on your Utility bill. When sending your payment in please make sure and <a href="tear off the bottom portion of the post card">tear off the bottom portion of the post card</a>, the <a href="teap portion is your copy">upper portion is your copy</a>. You may need to write your manual reading on the stub of the post card if you still have a manual read meter when you-drop off your payment.

Water Bills are due the 15th of each month. If you are still one of the 7 manual reads, you are required to send in your water reading. If you do not send in a water <u>meter reading</u> you will be **charged a penalty fee of \$10.00. This is only if your meter is a manual read meter.** Any bill that is delinquent more than 60 days can legally be shut off. If you can't pay your bill in full—make a partial payment. If you can't pay anything at least send in or CALL in a meter reading—You will at least save yourself the \$10 penalty. Leave a message after hours or write it on a piece of paper with your address and drop in the drop box. There is a shut-off fee of \$25 and a reconnect fee of \$25. Auto reads do not need to write any meter readings.

- ♦ SIDEWALKS—PER CITY CODE PROPERTY OWNERS WHO HAVE SIDEWALKS ADJACENT TO THEIR PROPERTY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING SNOW/ICE FROM THE SIDEWALK WITH IN 24 HOURS.

- Spring reminder—if you are thinking of a fence, it requires a zoning permit. Any shed over 200 square feet requires a building permit., sheds 200 sq feet or less requires a zoning permit. Please see City Ordinance on the City Website page for additional information.
- ♦ 2023 Recycle calendars are available. They are located with the newsletters in the clear weather proof box located on the front of city hall. You can always pick one up at Security Bank, or during city office hours. Waste Management Holidays are New Year, Memorial, Independence, Labor, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day. 




