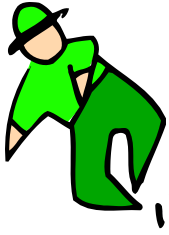
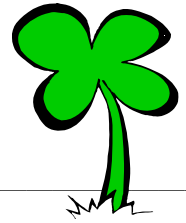

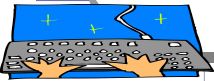

- Hazardous Waste, Fluorescent bulbs, or auto batteries—no charge
- Fees apply as noted below

Car tires (rims accepted) , Semi Truck tire (rim accepted)
Car/truck/SUV tires

Air Conditioners, Sofa/Couch , Appliances, Electronics, TV/Monitors.

Mattresses , Carpet Rolls, Box Springs, Recliners/Chairs, Hide-a-beds

Small Furniture , Lawnmowers **THERE WILL ONLY BE SPRING RECYCLING—NO FALL RECYCLING.**

Note—There is a large container on that day at the city shed to take almost any kind of miscellaneous junk cluttering your yard, we also will have trailers available for scrap metal. Any miscellaneous garbage is free to dispose of if it is not mentioned above. Call the office to schedule help if you need assistance hauling a large item to the site. They will help you.

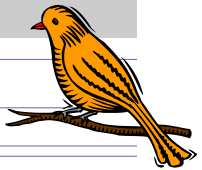


