Join the Carver County Sheriff's Office Community Watch

About:

The Carver County Sheriff's Office invites you to register your residential or business security camera (s) with our Community Watch program. The purpose of the Community Watch Program is to foster a collaborative effort between the Sheriff's Office and the Citizen's of Carver County to strengthen the investigative capabilities of the Sheriff's Office as well as deter crime. The Community Watch program is essentially the "Neighborhood Watch" of the 21st century.

How it Works:

When a crime occurs in your area, the Sheriff's Office may contact you to see if you have security footage of the incident. If you have security footage of the incident, the Sheriff's Office may request a copy of the footage for investigative and/or evidentiary purposes.

Why You Should Know:

- Registering your cameras does not give the Carver County Sheriff's Office direct access to your camera.
- Participation is voluntary and free.
- You may withdrawal your registration at any time. Participation information will be kept private.

<u>PLEASE READ THE PARKING ORDINANCE—</u> <u>SEVERAL TRALERS IN VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE</u> § 70.15 OVERTIME PARKING; PARKING OF COMMER-CIAL VEHICLES.

No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle, non-motor vehicle or trailer whether attended or unattended, upon any public street, public alleyway or public lot for a period of time longer than 24 consecutive hours. No trucks licensed at a gross vehicle weight above 15,000 pounds, and requiring street or public alleyway between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle or trailer unless it is in the process of being loaded or unloaded so as to block any public street or public alleyway at any time. (Ord. 85-A, passed 5-16-2017) Penalty, see § 10.99

§ 70.16 NO PARKING ZONES AND LIMITED PARKING ZONES.

The City Council may also, from time to time, designate certain streets and alleys or portions thereof, as "no parking" zones or as "limited parking" zones for a period of time. These zones would be properly marked to reflect their parking character. (Ord. 85-A, passed 5-16-2017)

92.02 (Q) Storage of shipping containers, storage containers, temporary structures, and the storage of boats, campers, trailers and other recreational related items shall not remain in one area for more than 180 days. Items that are required to be licensed shall be currently licensed and shall be parked on a impervious, concrete or asphalt surface.
