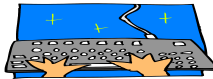

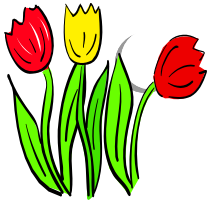

12 PM, Carver County Spring Clean Up.

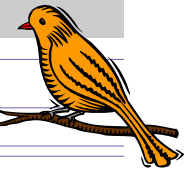
