Resident Reminders & News

Reminder to residents—letters have been going out for non mowed lawns, this is your responsibility to maintain your lawn, anything over 6" you will receive a letter from the city. The ordinances are posted below, please read and abide by the ordinances, ordinances are put in place to protect all residents.

As a safety precaution remember to lock vehicles and secure your property and during night hours or when away. It is a best practice to make sure your property is secure at all times.

July 21 Carver County is scheduled to chip seal county road 33, please do not park on the street during this time. City streets will be chip sealed at a later date, please watch the newsletter for updates of when and what streets are slated for 2025.

Weather Siren—there has been a few issues with the weather sirens this year, the city is in the process of repairing and testing the sirens. The sirens are tested the first Wednesday of every month, if you do not hear any sirens please immediately report this to the City Clerk and or Fire Chief.

Farm Animals—90.12 The owning, breeding, raising, maintaining, selling or buying of livestock in the city is prohibited in all areas, except within the Agriculture (A) district. Livestock definition—90.01 farm animals Those animals commonly associated with a farm or performing work in an agriculture setting. Unless otherwise defined, FARM ANIMALS shall include members of the equestrian family (donkeys, horses, mules), bovine family buffalo, cows, bulls), sheep, poultry (guinea hens, chickens, turkeys), fowl (ducks, geese), swine (including Vietnamese pot-bellied pigs), goats, Llamas, bees and other animals associated with a farm, ranch or stable.

Grass and or weeds 92.02 (6) - Grass and/or weeds which have grown upon any property to a height of 6 or more inches. Overgrown, uncontrolled vegetation, shrubs, trees, and vines that are conducive to the accumulation of refuse, debris or the harborage of vermin.

92.02 (q) Storage of shipping containers, storage containers, temporary structures, and the storage of boats, campers, trailers and other recreational related items shall not remain in one area for more than 180 days. Items that are required to be licensed shall be currently licensed and shall be parked on a impervious, concrete or asphalt surface

Accessory structure should be kept in a workmanlike state of maintenance and repair. Junk equipment or salvage part storage is not allowed. Cont'd on next page.

CONTINUED CITY CODE **PLEASE READ THE PARKING ORDINANCE—SEVERAL TRAILERS IN VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE**

§ 70.15 OVERTIME PARKING; PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES.

No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle, non-motor vehicle or trailer whether attended or unattended, upon any public street, public alleyway or public lot for a period of time longer than 24 consecutive hours. No trucks licensed at a gross vehicle weight above 15,000 pounds, and requiring street or public alleyway between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. No person shall park or leave any motor vehicle or trailer unless it is in the process of being loaded or unloaded so as to block any public street or public alleyway at any time. (Ord. 85-A, passed 5-16-2017) Penalty, see § 10.99 **No TRAILERS ON STREET!!!**

§ 70.16 NO PARKING ZONES AND LIMITED PARKING ZONES.

The City Council may also, from time to time, designate certain streets and alleys or portions thereof, as “no parking” zones or as “limited parking” zones for a period of time. These zones would be properly marked to reflect their parking character. (Ord. 85-A, passed 5-16-2017)
