WATER/SEWER BILL INFORMATION



City of New Germany

JANUARY 2026

Water and sewer rates will slightly increase for 2026, this will take place on the January billing cycle. Monthly base rate for Water will be \$35.32, all water usage will be billed at \$0.02428 per gallon of water. The monthly meter fee is \$1.94. The monthly base rate for Sewer is \$32.99, sewer usage rate for all usage is \$0.02552 per gallon. Garbage rates increased in October 2025 to the following rates; 35 gallon SR rate \$9.87, 35 gallon \$11.27, 64 gallon \$14.27, 96 gallon \$16.58, recycling \$5.96. We are currently in contract negotiations for the 2026 rates.

Options for paying your Utility Bill: Security Bank New Germany, Regular Mail, Drop box on the front of City Hall.

Water Bills are due the 15th of each month. If you are still one of the few manual reads, you will be receiving a phone call to replace your manual head with a radio read head, everyone will then be on radio reads. Any bill that is delinquent more than 60 days can legally be shut off. If you can't pay your bill in full—make a partial payment. There is a shut-off fee of \$25 and a reconnect fee of \$25.

- ◆ SNOW PARKING RULES ARE IN EFFECT NOVEMBER 1—MARCH 31, NO PARKING ON CITY STREETS BETWEEN 2 AM—7 AM. NO PARKING ON CITY STREETS FOLLOWING A SNOWFALL OF 1" OR MORE. THE SHERIFF DEPT WILL ISSUE TICKETS!
- ◆ KEEP GARBAGE CANS IN YOUR DRIVEWAY NOT ON THE STREET DURING WINTER PLOWING SEASON.
- ◆ IT IS UNLAWFUL UNDER MN STATE STATUE 160.27 SUBD. 5 TO PLOW SNOW FROM DRIVEWAYS ON-TO OR ACROSS COUNTY/CITY ROADS.
- ◆ SIDEWALKS—PER CITY CODE, PROPERTY OWNERS WHO HAVE SIDEWALKS ADJACENT TO THEIR PROPERTY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING SNOW/ICE FROM THE SIDEWALK WITHIN 24 HOURS.
- ◆ City hall has received renovations! If in need of a rental call today! New in 2026 New Germany City Resident will receive \$100 off a rental, rental fees for 2026 are \$725 full rental and \$525 one level, resident would receive a \$100 discount off these prices. The City did receive a federal grant from Emmer's office for 2.2 million, it certainly helps, still need the 2026 bonding bill for the project to move forward.

- ◆ Exterior storage—furniture, appliances, car toppers, car parts, building material, brush, junk, debris and miscellaneous items not meant for outdoor storage and daily use cannot be stored outside or in your yard. Check Ordinances on the city website.
- ◆ House's must be kept in sound condition and free from deterioration. All house numbers must be visible from the street. If emergency personnel cannot find your home in a timely manner, it could be a difference of life and death.
- ◆ Spring reminder—if you are thinking of a fence, it requires a zoning permit. Sheds over 200 square feet or more requires a zoning permit. Please see City Ordinance on the City Website page for additional information.
- ◆ **REMINDER—PLEASE DO NOT PUSH OR PLOW SNOW ACROSS THE CITY STREET OR ONTO THE CITY STREET. MAKE SURE YOUR PILES OF SNOW ARE NOT ENCROACHING ONTO THE CITY STREETS.**

Water Softener Maintenance

The City of New Germany's water hardness is 23 grains per gallon.

Here is a few reasons to check your water softness hardness setting;

- Water feels to soft
- Your dishes become very spotty and show residue
- You use an excessive amount of salt
- You have additional contaminants in your water such as iron
- Your water may taste different
- Regular maintenance can save costly repairs & high water bills. It is good to do an annual check on water softener & call a professional for maintenance.
