

Every year in May your sewer portion of your utility bill is refigured and is based on your water usage from the Jan/Feb/March. This is a fixed fee for the next 12 months. The sewer base rate is \$32.99 and it is billed per 10 gallons at \$0.02552, or \$25.52 per 1,000 gallons. This will reflect in your May utility bill.


