
Easter Bunny

City Hall Rental Information

The upstairs dance area in the City Hall has recently undergone renovations, making it an ideal location for events and gatherings. Residents and businesses of New Germany are eligible for a \$100 discount on hall rental fees, must be a resident renting for your event only.

- Rental fee for the entire hall: \$725
- Rental fee for basement or upper level (one level): \$525
- Rental fee for day before or day after event: \$100
- Damage deposit: \$525


