City of New Germany

Compost bin is at the City Shed at 250 State Avenue N, only place grass clippings and leaves in the bin. Branches and larger items please bring to the Mayer compost location; county road 30 east, cross the bridge, 2nd gate on the left. Open on Wednesdays 5—8 PM, and Saturdays 8 AM—Noon, April—November. December through March Saturdays 8 AM—12 PM.

Ordinance code 92.03 (O) Shipping containers, storage containers, temporary structures, and the storage of boats, campers, trailers and other recreational relate items shall not remain in one area for more than 180 days. Items that are required to be licensed shall be currently licensed and shall be parked on an impervious, concrete or asphalt surface.



Residents can help keep our city clean, safe, and welcoming by removing junk, debris, unused items, and overgrown vegetation from their properties. Well-maintained yards and exterior areas improve neighborhood appearance, support public safety, and show community pride. Thank you for helping keep our city looking its best.

Recent notices have addressed issues such as unlicensed vehicles, debris, automobile parts, thistles, overgrown weeds or lawns, and missing impervious pads. Properties that are not kept clean and orderly can affect the appearance and value of nearby homes. Please take pride in your property and help keep our community clean and well maintained.

When the City Council authorizes a property maintenance notice, the enforcement process generally includes these steps:

1. A letter is sent identifying the violation.
2. A deadline is given to correct the issue.
3. If the property remains out of compliance, a second notice is mailed.
4. If the issue is not corrected, the city may complete the cleanup. Equipment may be billed at \$75 per hour, depending on the equipment used, plus \$20 per hour for each employee.
5. Cleanup costs may be collected through a lien on the property or assessed to property taxes, and fines may apply.
6. If the property remains noncompliant, the matter may be referred to the Carver County Attorney or City Attorney for further action.

fore starting a project, contact the City Of-
fice to confirm whether a permit is needed
and help avoid delays or added costs. For

Reminders

*Utility bills are due on the 15th of each
month. Payment options include mail, the
drop box outside City Hall, Security Bank,
and the online portal. Through the online
portal, you can register for autopay, Text
& Pay, or ACH payments; view your bill;
and choose paperless billing. Because
postage costs have increased, residents
who view their bills online are asked to
email the city at ngcityhall@gmail.com so
mailed bills can be discontinued. Register

The city will enforce delinquent utility
bills. After two months, you will receive a
disconnection notice; if the bill is not paid by
the disconnection date, service will be discon-
nected and additional fees will apply.*
